



## March-April 2016 Newsletter

Those who pre-fished at Miller's Ferry on Friday had a fairly good day on the water. However, fishing slowed on Saturday after a front passed through Friday night and the river had risen overnight.

Despite less than ideal conditions some anglers found some fish on Saturday and brought them to the scales. The Pope family Robinson found the most biting fish and brought five of them to the scales and their 7.73-pound stringer was good enough for first place. Second place went to the Grumpy Old Men team of Jim and Jerry who bagged four fish tipping the scales to 7.66 lbs. Bro. Jerry also snared a 3.87 largemouth and earned tournament lunger honors. The third place team was that of JR O'Gwynn and JR O'Gwynn who weighed in five fish at 7.51 lbs. Joe Kimbrough also fished alone and took fourth place 5.83 lbs. The last prize-winning place went to Chuck Vinson and Justin Tyner with 3 fish weighing 3.29 lbs.

The April tournament out of Hurst Hammock saw eleven boats and twenty-one anglers on the water looking for old bucket mouth. Tony Lister and his son, Chris, found five of those fish weighing in at 12.59 lbs. which was well good enough to capture first place. Second place went to Crawford Odom and John Werdann with a net weight of 7.93 lbs. The team of Michael and Melissa Johnson whose five fish tipped the scales at 6.47 lbs. Justin Tyner and Jim Hardy finished in fourth place with 6.28 lbs. Dragging up the rear was the team of Jeff Weaver and Marion Johnson with a 4.90 (net) lb. creel.
